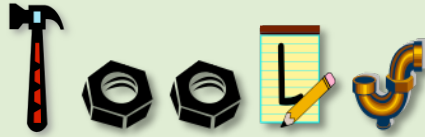


POSITIVE DISCIPLINE IN THE CLASSROOM
